Social/Emotional

- Engage In Pretend Play
- Comfort Others Who Are Hurt
- Changes Behaviour According To Where They are
- Likes To Be A Helper

Fine Motor

- Unbuttons Some Buttons
- Hold Pencil Appropriately
- Draw Detailed Shapes And Figures

Gross Motor

- Serves Himself Food/ Pour Water
- Independently Takes Care of Personal Hygiene
- Can Ride 2 wheeled Cycle
